RULES AND GUIDELINES

PRE-GAME

Participants should arrive 30 minutes before the event starts to submit waivers and check-in Players will NOT be allowed to participate without a signed waiver by a parent/guardian Coaches must check-in prior to their first game to be eligible to coach Only registered players and coaches will be allowed on the court during the event

GAMEPLAY

All games will be officiated for fairness

Teams should report to their designated game court 5-minutes prior to their start time Teams need 3 players to start their game

All players MUST wear their assigned team shirts during the game for identification All games will be played half court

Opening round games will be 10 minutes (running clock)

Playoff games will be 12 minutes (clock stops after change of possessions under 2 minutes)

Game calculations: WIN = 2, LOSS = 0, TIE = 1

NO timeouts in opening round

Teams will be responsible for their fan's behavior and cleanliness

IN-GAME

"Losers out" rule will be in effect in all rounds

The ball must be checked after every made basket or change of possession

Baskets will be counted by 1's and 2's

Offense must be started with a pass in to a teammate

The ball must be "taken back" to the 3-point line to start the offense

Offensive rebounds can be scored without taking the ball back

On-floor fouls will restart the possession

Made baskets on shooting fouls will be counted as "and-1" and change possession

Substitutions will take place every 5 minutes

Fighting, cursing or excessive fouling will NOT BE tolerated

Any player found to be causing harm to other players or staff will be ejected immediately

Harassment or belittling of the officials or other staff members will result in a forfeit

"Stalling" by holding the ball on offense is not allowed

A 5-second shot clock will be enforced if a team is perceived to be stalling

Jump ball possessions will be awarded to the defense



RULES AND GUIDELINES

FORMAT

Teams will play at least 4 games in the opening round
Playoff seeding will be determined by points total from game results
Ties in points will go to head-to-head matchup then total score, if necessary
One game elimination in the playoff rounds
Teams will be given one 30-sec timeout in the playoff round only
Fouls under 1-minute mark will result in free throws in playoff round only
Free throws are worth 1 point
Intentional fouls are awarded 1 free throw and possession after the shot

POST-GAME

Teams must clean their respective bench areas after each game Players and coaches should shake hands in good sportsmanship after each game Teams should report their win, loss or tie to their game monitor or director Teams should check the game board to confirm standings and schedule

AWARDS

MVP (best overall player)
Lock Down (best defender)
Overtime (best teammate, attitude and energy)
Curry (3-point contest winner)

3-POINT CONTEST

This contest will take place on the break between the opening round and playoffs 6 shooters will be selected by the Overtime staff
Participants will be selected based on their in-game shooting performance
Recommendations by coaches are allowed but final selections are non-debatable
